Nik Prachand, an epidemiologist at the Chicago Department of Public Health, will describe the results of a four-year federal project which aims to provide the first-ever, population-based estimates of demographic, social and behavioral characteristics associated with HIV infection and the use of testing and prevention services in Chicago. This ongoing project, which focuses on men who have sex with men (MSM), injection drug users, and at-risk heterosexuals, uncovers important findings for HIV prevention practitioners and policymakers.
